- 1. Thank you for your entry. You will be allocated your competition number at the start of the event. Please ensure at the start that you have been entered in the correct class for the event.
- 2. Scrutiny will be held in the car park at McCrorys Bar, Dunnamore, Cookstown, Co. Tyrone. (Map O.S.N.I. Discoverer Series 1:50000 Sheet 13 The Sperrins Grid 7925 8395. Scrutiny starts at 1900 hrs (7 pm) and will operate on a first come first served basis. Following scrutiny please make your way to the function room for signing on/documentation. After scrutiny cars should be parked in the car park opposite the McCrorys Bar. Please drive with care in and around the complex as we wish to retain our good relationship.
- 3. The finish will be at the McCrory's Bar i.e. same as Start.
- 4. The following types of Navigation may be used on the event for Class 1 & 2:-Map References, Straight Line or Circular Herringbone, Grid Lines, Spot Heights, Tulip Diagrams, Directions, Features, Mirror Image. Class 3 & 4 will use Grid References, Tulip Diagram and Grid Lines
- 5. Types of section: Regularity and Competitive Relaxed.
- 6. Maps O.S.N.I. Discoverer Series F Edition 1:50000 Sheet 13 "F" Edition The Sperrins Crown Copyright 2015. Co-ordinate limits are :- N-90, S-70, E-85, W-70. D Edition of the map also works.
- 7. Measured Mile: Will be provided on the road towards Churchtown. Exact details to be advised at signing on.
- 8. MSA Permit No. **106729** has been issued for this event.

- 10. On arrival beginners must identify themselves to the Secretary Jason McGuckin. Beginners will be able to avail of assistance before and during the event. Class 3 & 4 will be given the same instructions with Class 3 receiving some instructions on route.
- 11. Two Targa Tests will run within RELAXED sections of the event (8 & 10 mins) and once completed you must move directly to the next Time Control as per the instructions.
- 12. After the Drivers & Navigators Brief at 8.15 pm and having satisfactorily completed scrutiny and signed on Classes 3 & 4 are to move to 'Parc Ferme' as directed for release of respective route instruction information at 8.15 pm and then to TCA (Start) on release from 'Parc Ferme'. Any Class 1 & 2 personnel found in the 'Parc Ferme' area will be excluded from the event.
