Final Instructions 1 / Competitors Brief

1. Thank you for your entry. Your competition number will be published on the club website – cookstownmotorclub.com and on the Rallyscore website, on Thursday 25th July 2019.
2. Motorsport UK permit number 113940 has been allocated for this event.
3. Special Tests will be timed to the second.
4. Competition cars will start each stage on 1minute intervals except for Tests 6,12 and 18 which are stopwatch timed at the discretion of the Timekeepers.
5. Scrutiny will be at Sandy Arthur compound, Aghanloo Industrial Estate, Limavady, BT49 0HE, on Saturday 27th July, from 07:00hrs to 09:00hrs. Competitors failing to be signed on at this time may be excluded from the event.
6. You will have confirmed on your entry form that the competition car is compliant with the Road Traffic Act within the country of its registration. MOT / NCT and road tax will NOT be checked, it is the competitor's own responsibility to make sure their car is legal to be on the public road for the event.
7. Documentation scrutiny will follow immediately after mechanical scrutiny, within the Sandy Arthur compound. Competition plates will be distributed at this time, these must be fixed to the car and this will be checked at the start control (TC A). Any competitor failing to display plates will not be allowed to start.
8. First Car away from Benone at 10am, cars out at 2 per minute. This is to clear the car park asap for the Holidaymakers' cars. Thereafter the loop always goes back to Sandy Arthur's where cards are taken for results. Tea/Coffee will be served there on the second loop during a 30 minutes break, then large beef burger meals will be available at the Finish at Sandy Arthurs.
9. Results and Prizegiving at Sandy Arthurs as soon as results are Final.
10. PLEASE NOTE: STRICTLY 10MPH THROUGH THE CARAVAN PARK AREA FOLLWING TESTS 6, 12 AND 18 AS THIS IS A VERY BUSY AREA FOR PEDESTRIANS AND HOLIDAYMAKERS INCLUDING CHILDREN.
11. No trailers will be permitted in the Benone area for this event. A trailer park will be available at the Sandy Arthur compound throughout the day
12. No management or chase cars are required or permitted.

Timing:

Tests will start timing when the Start Timekeeper raises the red flag and timing ends at the Chequered Flag board at which you must Stop astride, then roll forward gently to the Finish Timekeeper.

One exception is Tests 6,12 and 18 which are timed by Stopwatch. Start Timekeeper will let the competitor know when to go and the timing ends at the Chequered Flag board. at which you must Stop astride, then roll forward gently to the Finish Timekeeper.
