Final Instructions 1 / Competitors Brief

- 1. Thank you for your entry. Your competition number is available on the club website http://www.cookstownmotorclub.com/tyrone-stages/ and on the Rallyscore website.
- 2. Scrutiny will be at Sandy Arthur compound, Aghanloo Industrial Estate, Limavady, BT49 0HE on the following timetable:

Friday 18th October, from 17:30hrs to 20:30hrs for all competitors (who have not paid for Saturday scrutiny).

Saturday 19th October for competitors who have paid for Saturday scrutiny from 07:00hrs to 08:30hrs.

- 3. At scrutiny competitors must produce a valid Motorsport UK / MI log book for the competition car.
- 4. Competition cars must be presented at scrutiny with helmets, clothing and front head restraints which must be produced for inspection.
- 5. You will have confirmed on your entry form that the competition car is compliant with the Road Traffic Act within the country of its registration. MOT / NCT and road tax will NOT be checked; it is the competitor's own responsibility to make sure their car is legal to be on the public road for the event.
- 6. Documentation scrutiny will follow immediately after mechanical scrutiny, within the Sandy Arthur compound. Competition plates will be distributed at this time, these must be fixed to the car and this will be checked at the start control (TC A). Any competitor failing to display plates will not be allowed to start.
- 7. Scrutiny closes at 09:00am sharp; any competitors not signed on at this time will not be permitted to start.
- 8. No trailers will be permitted in the service area for this event. If you arrive at Service with a trailer, you will be turned away. A trailer park will be available at the Sandy Arthur compound throughout the day. For competitors scrutineering on Friday evening, secure parking for the competition car and trailer will be available on the Sandy Arthur compound overnight.
- 9. The service area is at the Benone tourist complex, due to limited parking you will be limited to one service vehicle per competition car. The Service area will open at 7.30am Saturday 19th. There is no provision for overnight parking whatsoever. Please ensure your Service crews understand this. No management or chase cars are permitted. Waves Restaurant at the Benone complex will be open all day Saturday doing full breakfasts, tea, coffee, lunches and afternoon/evening lunches.
- 10. Competitors are reminded of SR 15.6:

Failure to follow specified stage route - MAXIMUM TIME FOR THAT STAGE

11. Please ensure that you familiarise yourself with the SOS / OK procedure which is detailed in the front of your road book.

12. The Competitors Relations Officer is Ian Porter. Ian will be available at sign on and around the Benone Tourist Complex, throughout the day.

- 13. Competitors are also reminded of SR13
 - Top 3 finishers may be required to participate in a post event photoshoot, which will require both competitors and competing cars. Failure to attend may result in competitor's exclusion from the results.
- 14. Competition cars will start each stage on 30 second intervals.
- 15. All competitors are to be at the Benone Complex for 10:00am, where the start times will be published on the official notice board at the centre.
- 16. There will be no verbal drivers briefing, please line up in starting order 5 minutes prior to your start time.
- 17. Time cards will be issued at the start line.
- 18. Please note, we will be using one sided arrows on the stages to reduce the time needed for the turnaround on stages, so you may notice some blank white boards on your way through the stages. Ignore any blank white boards, they mean nothing.

Any final instruction issued will serve as the competitor brief, there will be no verbal briefing.
